The military reservation located at Anchorage, Alaska, is announced as a permanent military post under the provisions of paragraph 2c, AR 210-10, and is designated Fort Richardson in honor of Brigadier General WILDS P. RICHARDSON, United States Army. Post Office address: Anchorage, Alaska.
